**OBSERVATION POINTS**

**ALACÓN MULADAR OBSERVATORY**

Access via a track in good condition from Alacón. A place of special interest to see large concentrations of Griffon Vultures. Egyptian Vultures are to be found here in the summer season, as well as several species of corvids; Common Raven, Carrion Crow and Jackdaw.

**MULADAR DE LA TORDA OBSERVATORY**

Access via a track in good condition from km 16 of the panoramic road A-1702, The Silent Route. It is opposite the feeding point for necrophagous birds managed by the Aragonese Network of Feeders for Necrophagous Birds.

**CABEZO GORDO BIRDWATCHING OBSERVATION POINT**

Access via track to the car park, followed by a signposted path of about 30 minutes on foot. Outstanding viewpoint for observing large birds of prey, one of the most interesting birding spots. Views of the north wall of the Organs of Montoro.

**MONASTERIO DEL OLIVAR HIDE**

**SETTING:** located in an old poplar grove next to the Esteruel riverbed. Surrounded by riverside vegetation, pine forest and close to agricultural areas and orchards.

**SPECIES:** wide variety of forest birds (passeriforms, finches and woodpeckers).

**FEATURES:** hide made of treated solid wood and sandwich panel roof, with spy glass and cover. Photographic setting with water.

**NUMBER OF PLACES:** 3/4 seated pax. (7/8 standing).

**RECOMMENDED SEASON:** All year round.

**ARIÑO HIDE**

**SETTING:** at the heart of the Martín River Cultural Park, notable for its ravines and rocky spurs surrounded by Aleppo pines, junipers and rosemary.

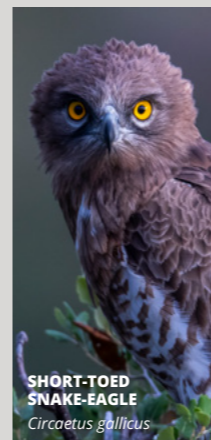
**SPECIES:** scrubland species (wheathears, warblers...).

**FEATURES:** hide made of treated solid wood and sandwich panel roof, with spy glass and cover. Photographic setting with water.

**NUMBER OF PLACES:** 2/3 seated pax. (4/5 standing).

**RECOMMENDED SEASON:** spring, autumn and winter.

Found in the northern part of Teruel Province, the Andorra and Sierra de Arcos county is the smallest and one of the least well-known of the province.

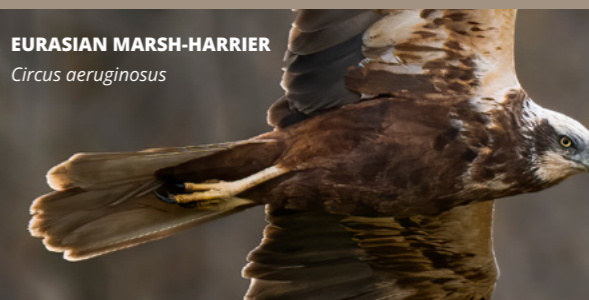
This is a transition landscape between the last foothills of the Iberian mountain system and the Ebro valley. As a result there is a wide range of habitats - from the escarpments of the Arcos and Ejlue sierras, from which the Majalinos peak rises, to the riparian forests of the Escuriza, Esteruel and Martín rivers, through the cereal plains of Andorra and Alloza, scattered with olive trees, up to the limestone rocky gorges like those at Mortero de Alacón, a natural sanctuary which was once a prehistoric ceremonial site.

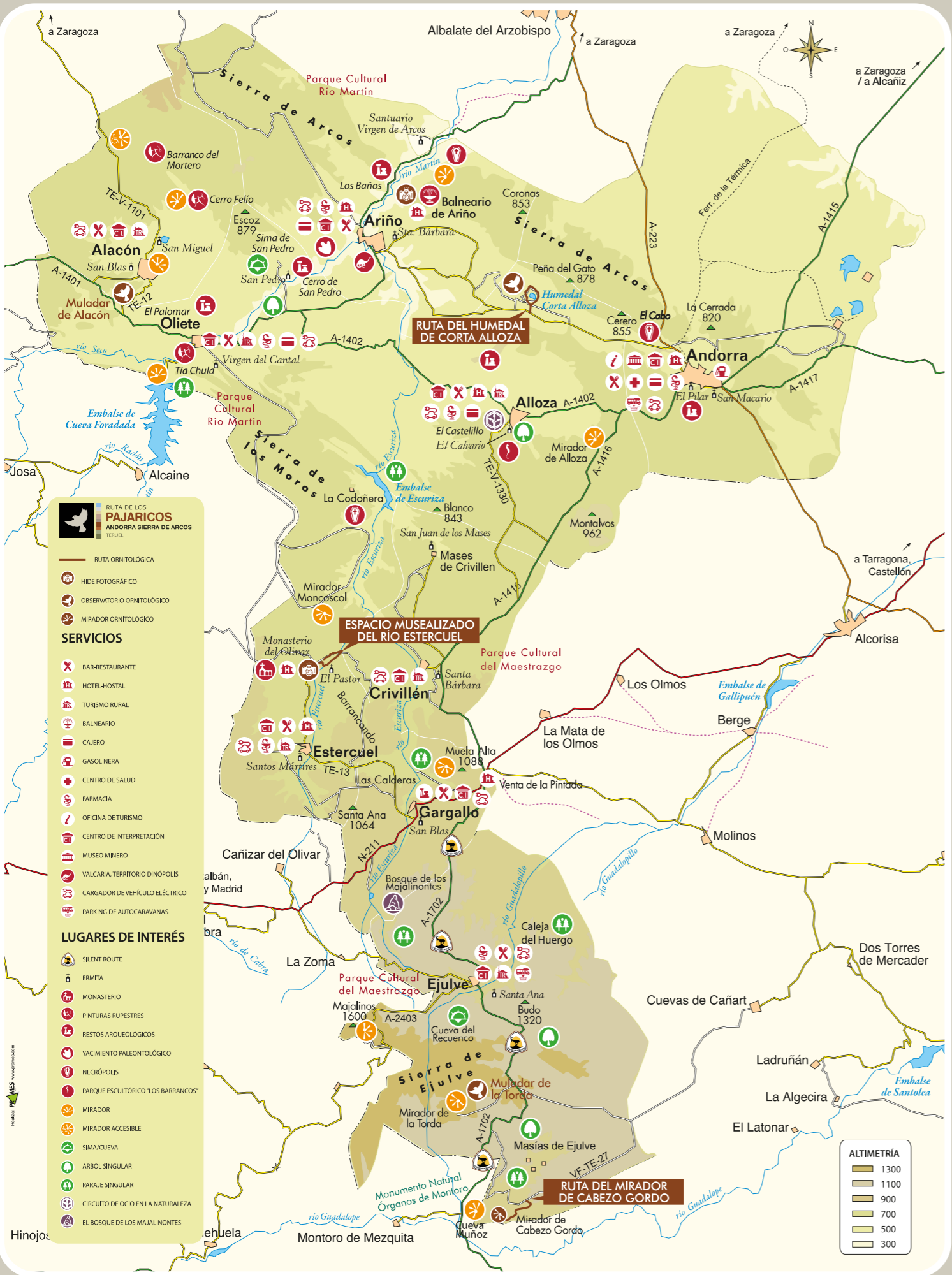
Such varied topography and the wealth of the plant life found here, combined with streams and other wetland areas provide ideal conditions for a wide representation of Mediterranean fauna.

Travel in silence through the different landscapes and habitats of Andorra-Sierra de Arcos and discover the great variety of bird species to be found there.

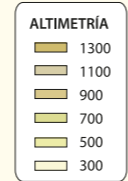

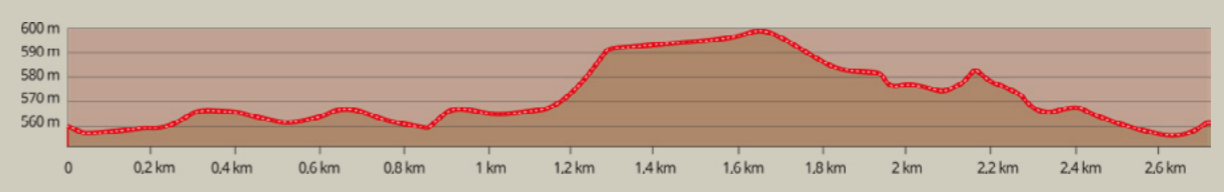
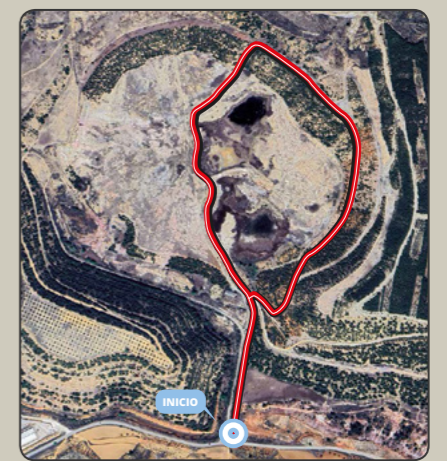

## CORTA ALLOZA WETLAND ROUTE

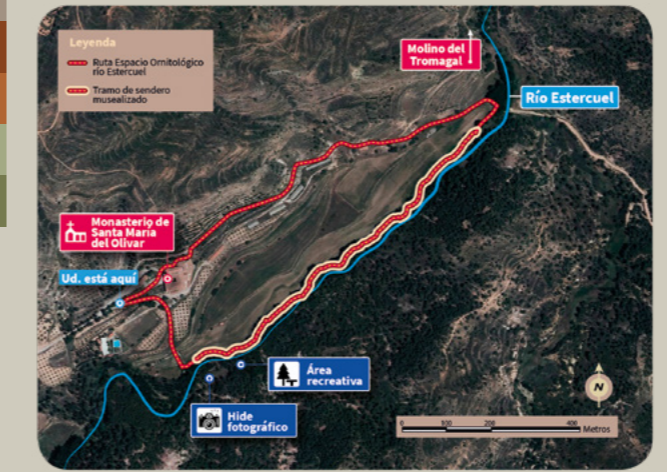
The route starts next to the old mining track that connects the towns of Andorra and Alloza. The paved road leads to an old workshop building. The recently installed **observatory-screen** allows you to look out over the first of the water basins. Crossing the pasture, you will reach an **elevated viewing point** that gives you a general view of the wetland.

**SPECIES:** Mallard, Little Grebe, Pochard, Eurasian Coot, Eurasian Moorhen, Marsh Harrier, Grey Heron, Little Ringed Plover, White Wagtail, Corn Bunting, Sardinian Warbler, Black Redstart, Stonechat, European Goldfinch, Common Chaffinch, Blackcap, Great Tit, Thekla Lark, Eurasian Skylark, Black-eared Wheatear and Woodlark.

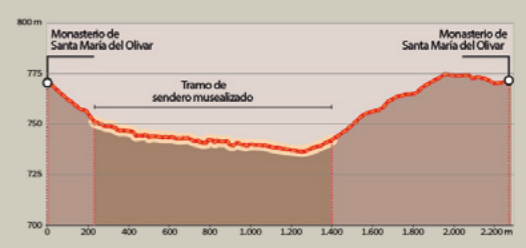


## ESTERCUEL RIVER OUTDOOR MUSEUM ROUTE

This path follows the recently renovated PR-TE 93 trail. It starts at the monastery gate and descends between orchards to the river plain, where it takes the path that leads to the Tromagal mill. Along the route, a series of 3D reproductions of birds, accompanied by information panels, will help visitors discover some of the interesting birds of the area.



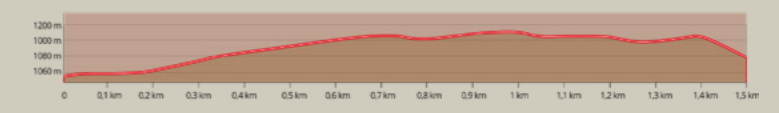
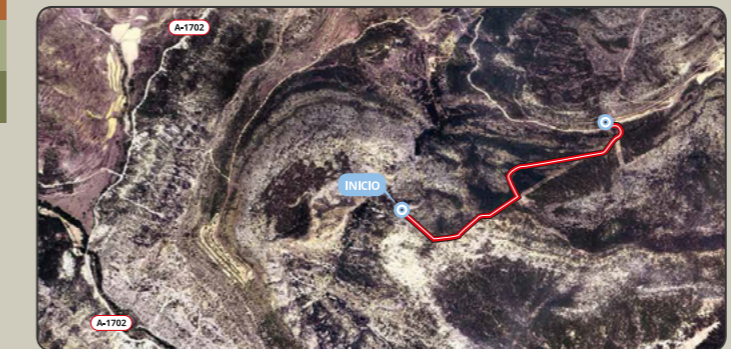
**SPECIES:** Common Blackbird, European Robin, Chaffinch, Great tit, Blue tit, Great Spotted Woodpecker, Common Nightingale, Wood Pigeon, Mistle Thrush, Cetti's Warbler, Corn Bunting, Eurasian Skylark, Thekla Lark, Green Woodpecker and European Goldfinch.



## CABEZO GORDO VIEWPOINT ROUTE

This route takes us past the impressive views of the Guadalupe River, Villarluengo and a good part of the Maestrazgo mountain range.

There will be large birds of prey overhead as well as other rock birds such as crag martins and swifts. At the end of the track, a short stretch of path descends to the **birdlife viewing point**, from where we can admire the view of the Cueva Muñoz ravine, steeply sloped terrain very close to the **Órganos de Montoro**.



**SPECIES:** Griffon Vulture, Goshawk, Sparrowhawk, Peregrine Falcon, Egyptian Vulture, Bearded Vulture, Short-toed Snake Eagle, Booted Eagle, Little Owl, Tawny Owl, Great Tit, Coal Tit, Blue Tit, Crested Tit, Eurasian Treecreeper, Skylark, Woodlark, Chaffinch, Brambling, Redwing, Fieldfare, Black Redstart, Chiffchaff, Blackcap, Sardinian Warbler, Thekla Lark, Spotted Flycatcher, Pied Flycatcher, House Martin, Barn Swallow, Crag Martin, Common Swift and Alpine swift.
